

Environmental Policy

RODA GOLFCOURSE, S.L., a company whose activity is based on the management and maintenance of golf courses, is firmly aware of its obligation towards the protection and improvement of the environment. It recognises that respect towards the environment is linked to human well-being and sporting excellence, which in the case of golf, is translated into harmonious integration with nature and a rational use of natural resources.

For this reason, RODA GOLF COURSE, S.L. intends to improve its relationship with the environment by establishing a "Sustainable Development Plan" and has consequently developed a System of Environmental Management in accordance with the ISO 14001 standard. This standard will provide the framework for the environmental objectives and goals established and revised in order to ensure a process of continuous improvement. The guidelines of this standard are as follows:

1. Complying with the legislation in force and its reforms concerning the environment, such as regulations, directives, rules and other requirements which the company must adhere to.
2. Carrying out an effective management of water resources, by always using purified waste water for the watering of golf courses, and being conscious of the importance of applying an appropriate management and use of this resource.
3. Preserving bio-diversity in order to maximize the ecological potential of the golf course.
4. Protecting the environment within the golf course itself, taking into consideration environmental variables in all its initiatives and applying possible techniques to minimize any environmental issues and impacts, such as the use of resources, and aspiring to continually improve, providing that it is technically and economically viable.
5. RODA GOLF COURSE, S.L. management will constantly search to find alternative ways to reduce, reutilize or recycle by-products generated by the company.

RODA GOLF COURSE, S.L. will develop and apply the present ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY at all levels of the company and in all activities and processes through its System of Environmental Management established according to the UNE-EN-ISO 14001:2.004 regulation with the aim of continually progressing in its commitment to the environment.
